## **The Scarsdale Congregational Church Nursery School Distance Learning**

At SCCNS we believe consistency is incredibly important for children. Continuous learning at home helps to keep children engaged, connected, and focused. As such, our staff has created a robust distance learning plan for times during which we may be unable to perform in-person instruction.

### **What can I expect from a 2s, 3s, or 4s Distance Learning Plan?**

- Teachers will provide parents with weekly “What’s to Come” emails detailing upcoming themes, concepts, and activities
  - Weekly thematic lesson planning will include reinforcement of skills such as fine motor, colors, letters, and numbers, as well as new concepts
  - Virtual gatherings, at an appropriate length for each age group, will be held daily with the entire class to allow for activities like circle time, show & tell, and story time; *although optional, attendance is encouraged as these help to reinforce your child’s connection with his or her teachers and classmates*
  - Teachers will also host smaller group and/or 1-on-1 video calls for more personalized instruction
  - When possible, lesson planning as well as preparation of materials will be completed in advance to allow time for lesson kits to be delivered to (or picked up by) each participating child
  - Our specials teachers will continue to send weekly, full-length classes covering Music, Musical Performance, Spanish, and Movement
  - Parents will be encouraged to share pictures of their children’s completed projects and assignments; this will provide the opportunity for your child to receive positive feedback
  - As always, our teachers will be available to answer any questions or concerns throughout the week
